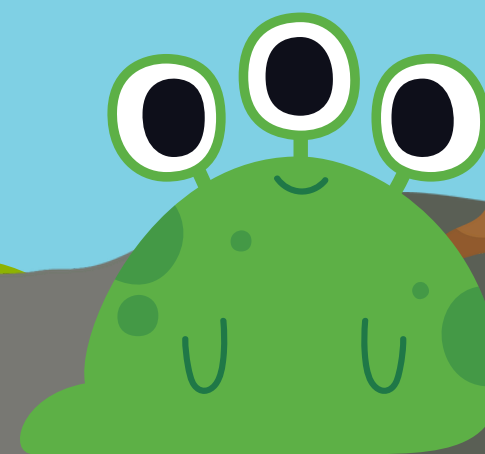




MATH MONSTER



HOW TO PLAY

THIS GAME IS A FUN WAY TO TEST YOUR MATH SKILLS
AND LEARN ABOUT BEING A GOOD FRIEND!

1. **Choose a level:** Start with the easy questions. When you feel ready, move on to medium, hard, and then challenge.
2. **Read each question carefully:** Each question will be a word problem about numbers and sometimes doing the right thing.
3. **Solve the problem:** Use your math skills to figure out the answer. Think about adding, subtracting, multiplying, or dividing.
4. **Look at the answer choices:** There are four possible answers, but only one is correct.
5. **Choose the right answer:** Pick the answer you think is right and check to see if you got it correct.
6. **Keep going!** See how many questions you can answer correctly in each level.

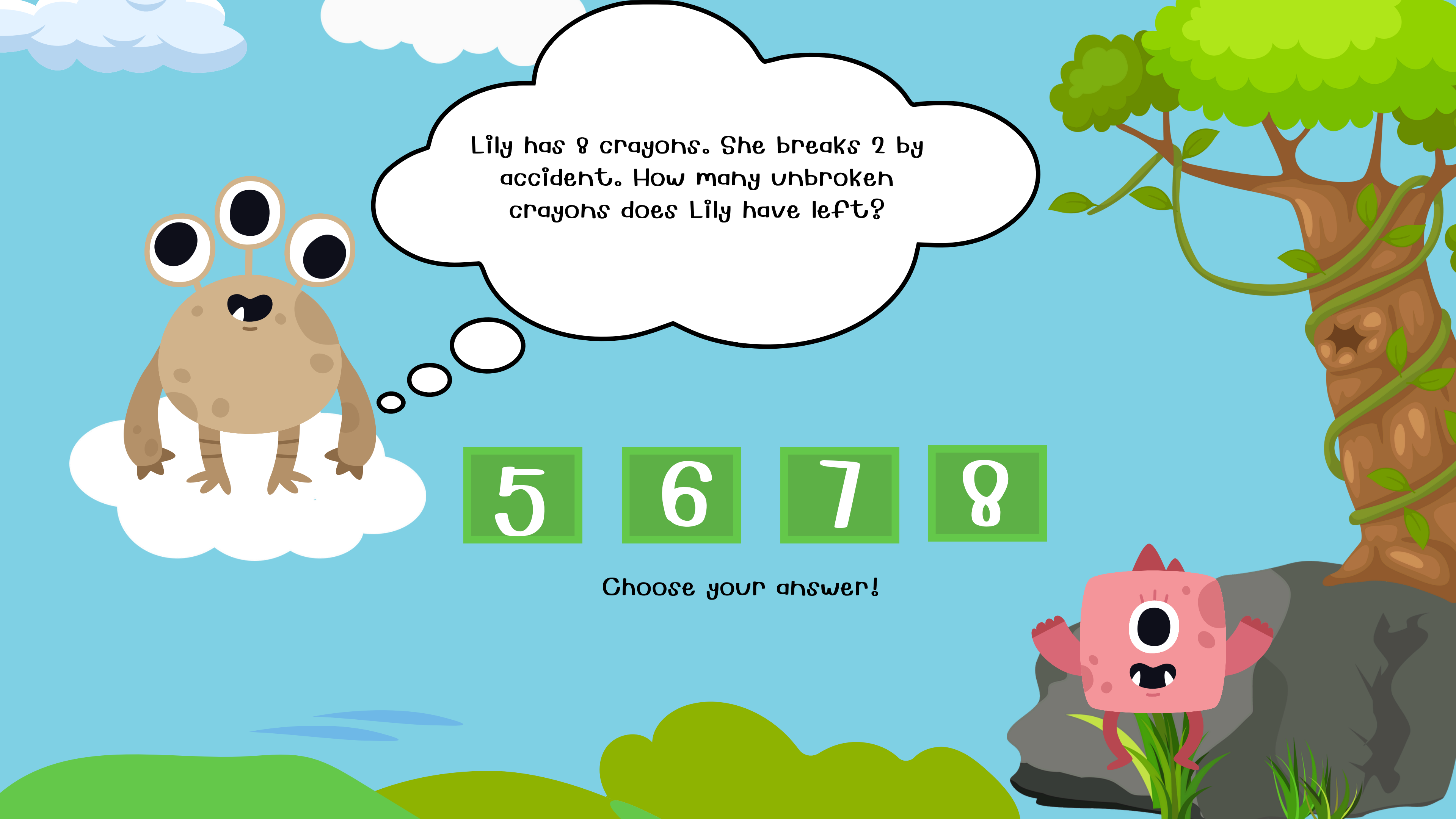

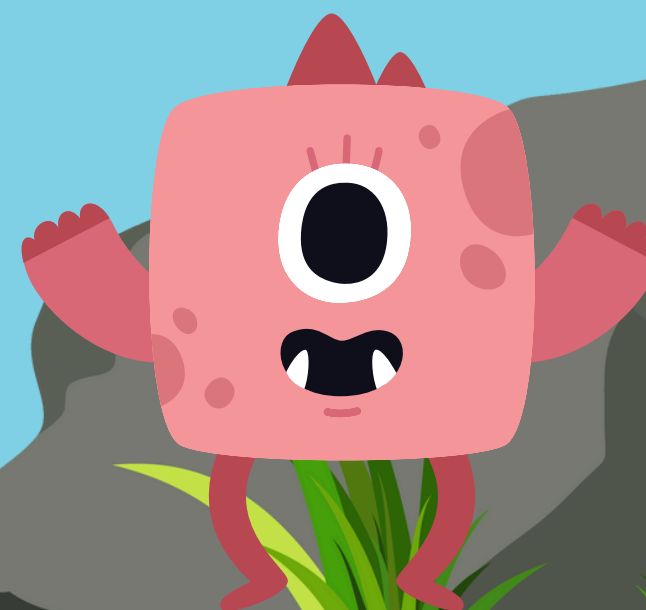

Isabella has 36 pieces of candy in total (3 bags * 12 pieces/bag = 36 pieces). Since there are 3 people sharing (Isabella and her 2 brothers), each person gets 12 pieces (36 pieces / 3 people = 12 pieces/person).
